1. EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

- 1.1. The event will be known as the “Panasonic Air Conditioning Sydney SuperNight 400”, hereinafter referred to as “the Event” incorporating the Repco Supercars Championship, to be held at Sydney Motorsport Park, Eastern Creek, New South Wales on 18th – 21st July 2024.

2. ORGANISATION AND STATUS

- 2.1. The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport Australia, the Circuit Race Standing Regulations (CRSR) published by Motorsport Australia, relevant Championship and/or Series Sporting and Technical Regulations as approved by Motorsport Australia, these Supplementary Regulations, Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins.
- 2.2. Each support category will be a National Race status.

4. CIRCUIT DETAILS

- 4.1. Venue: Sydney Motorsport Park
- 4.2. Length: 3.91 kilometres
- 4.3. Direction: Racing is Anti-Clockwise in accordance with the Circuit Licence
- 4.4. Secretary of the Event Office: Located at the base of the Race Control Tower
- 4.5. Stewards Office: Located in the demountable buildings at the outside of the Race Control Building.
- 4.6. Notice Board: Available electronically via the Sportity App (password: **MSA24**)

5. ENTRIES & ENTRY FEES

- 5.1. Entries for the Event will open on distribution of these Supplementary Regulations.
- 5.2. All Competitors must complete the appropriate Entry Form for their category.
- 5.3. Entries for the Event will close on 8th July 2024. The completed Entry Form must be received by the relevant Category Manager/Administrator no later than this time.
- 5.4. The Entry Fee for these Event is as agreed between the relevant Category Manager/Administrator and the Promoter and is payable to the Category Manager/Administrator.
- 5.5. Entries for the Event are by invitation only and the submitting of an entry does not automatically imply an invitation was issued.
- 5.6. The maximum number of entries accepted for each Support Category Event will be as agreed between the Promoter and the relevant Category Manager/Administrator.
- 5.7. Entries to the Event may be refused in accordance with the NCR.

6. CATEGORIES

- 6.1. **2024 Porsche Carrera Cup Australia Championship: 1 x 45 mins and 2 x 25 min races (time certain):**
Conducted in compliance with the 2024 Porsche Paynter Dixon Carrera Cup Australia Championship Sporting and Technical Regulations as approved by Motorsport Australia.
- 6.2. **2024 TOYOTA GAZOO Toyota Gazoo Racing Australia GR Cup: 2 x 10 lap and 1 x 13 lap races (time certain):**
Conducted in compliance with the 2024 TOYOTA GAZOO Racing Australia GR Cup Sporting and Technical Regulations as approved by Motorsport Australia.
- 6.3. **2024 Tyrepower V8 SuperUtes Series: 1 x 25 min and 3 x 20 min races (time certain):**
Conducted in compliance with the 2024 Tyrepower V8 SuperUtes Series Sporting and Technical Regulations as approved by Motorsport Australia.
- 6.4. **2024 Touring Car Masters: 4 x 20 min races (time certain):**
Conducted in compliance with the 2024 Touring Car Masters Sporting and Technical Regulations as approved by Motorsport Australia.
- 6.5. **2024 National Sports Sedan Series: 3 x 20 mins races (time certain):**
Conducted in compliance with the 2024 National Sports Sedan Series Sporting and Technical Regulations as approved by Motorsport Australia.

7. EVENT SCHEDULE

- 7.1. The Event Schedule is attached, any changes will be updated in the *Further Supplementary Regulations*.
- 7.2. The Event Schedule may be varied or altered at the Promoter's discretion to ensure that all Repco Supercars Championship sessions and races stay on schedule. You will be notified of any change as soon as possible and the Organisers will do everything possible to maintain your involvement as an important part of the program.
- 7.3. The Organiser reserves the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the Event or any part of the Event in accordance with the NCR.
- 7.4. There will be a number of parade laps, various demonstrations, and passenger rides at the Event and they will be conducted in accordance with the NCR and the [Motorsport Australia Motorsport Passenger Ride Activity Policy](#).

8. LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

- 8.1. Each Competitor must hold a Motorsport Australia Competition Licence unless they comply with 8.2.1 or 8.2.2 below.
- 8.2. Each Driver must hold a minimum of a Motorsport Australia Circuit Licence with provisional endorsement unless noted otherwise against a particular event or specified otherwise in the Sporting Regulations for the relevant Championship/Cup/Series/Trophy etc, or:
 - 8.2.1. Hold a Motor Sport New Zealand National C1/C2 Competition Licence and valid Tasman Visa for the Event; or
 - 8.2.2. Hold the minimum of the highest-grade National Licence issued by a foreign ASN required for the event and obtain an approval to compete from the ASN that issued their licence.
 - (i) Each such driver and competitor will be required to receive an authorisation to compete from Motorsport Australia prior to the Event and unless specified otherwise in category Sporting Regulations will not be eligible to score points in any Championship/Cup/Series/Trophy/etc connected with the Event.
- 8.3. The Organiser confirms that the circuit to be used for this Event holds the necessary Motorsport Australia National Track licence for each of the events nominated in these Supplementary Regulations

9. MEDICAL SERVICES

- 9.1. The Circuit Medical Centre is located between the VIP carpark and Supercars Paddock and will be operational during the following times **(AEST)**:
 - 9.1.1 Thursday 18th July 2024 0830 - 1830
 - 9.1.2 Friday 19th July 2024 0850 - 1930
 - 9.1.3 Saturday 20th July 2024 0945 - 2215
 - 9.1.4 Sunday 21st July 2024 0800 - 1945

10. ACCREDITATION CENTRE

- 10.1. The Accreditation Centre is located between Gate AA and Gate A off Ferrers Road.
- 10.2. The Accreditation Centre opening hours are as follows **(AEST)**:
 - 10.2.1 Thursday 18th July 2024 0800 – 1630
 - 10.2.2 Friday 19th July 2024 0700 – 1600
 - 10.2.3 Saturday 20th July 2024 0800 – 1600
 - 10.2.4 Sunday 21st July 2024 0800 – 1200
- 10.3. Competitors will be allocated personnel passes as arranged with each category manager/administrator.
- 10.4. No Team Vehicles are permitted to enter the support paddock. Any such vehicle parked in the support paddock without the correct pass will be towed to an area outside the paddock, and any costs incurred will be charged to the competitor.
- 10.5. Accreditation will be required from Friday 19th July 2024.

11. SUPPORT PADDOCK SPACE ALLOCATION

- 11.1. The Support Paddock allocation will be planned at the discretion of the Promoter in consultation with the relevant Category Manager/Administrator.

12. ACCESS TO THE CIRCUIT PROPERTY AND SUPPORT PADDOCKS

- 12.1. All accreditation will be scanned on entry to the circuit throughout the Event, and competitors should ensure that all persons associated with them are to keep their credential and some form of personal identification on or near them at all times which clearly identifies them as the person wearing the allocated credential.
- 12.2. All credentialed persons leaving the circuit and wishing to return the same day must ensure their credential is scanned out as they leave the Circuit. Credentials automatically reset at 00:00 each night for use the next day.
- 12.3. Competitors should note that there will be limited Security in this paddock throughout the Event and that they should take their own security precautions at all times, particularly while their Competition Automobile is on the track.
- 12.4. Transporter park up times will be outlined in the *Further Supplementary Regulations*. A detailed park up strategy will be provided to the Category Manager/Administrator by the Promoter.
- 12.5. Instructions will be distributed by the Category Managers/Administrators in conjunction with Supercars. Transporter meeting point for group entry to unload area and Event parking is at a separate location to the paddock.
- 12.6. No Transporters are allowed to enter the Circuit until the Category Manager/Administrator is onsite to facilitate park up.
- 12.7. It is prohibited to wash transporters at the Circuit.
- 12.8. All access lanes in and around the Race Paddock must be kept clear at all times during the Event including when unloading your Competition Automobile from your race transporter or trailer.
- 12.9. Competitors must work on their Competition Automobile within their category allocated paddock.
- 12.10. Competitors, including their associated people, are prohibited to sleep overnight in the Paddock area.
- 12.11. Where a competitor requires their personnel to work late into the evening and/or into the early hours of the following morning, they must first attain permission by advising their Category Manager/Administrator who then must seek permission from the Promoter.
- 12.12. Children in any restricted areas including the paddock must be under the direct supervision of their parent/carer. The Promoters reserve the right to have any offenders removed.
- 12.13. Support Competitors may not move from their allocated Support Paddock parking position on Sunday 21st July until 6pm unless otherwise instructed by Supercars management. A full detailed exit strategy will be provided to the Category Manager/Administrator by the Promoter.

13. PADDOCK AREA MOVEMENTS

- 13.1. All Competition Automobile movements to and from sessions are to travel in the one-way directions as shown on the Paddock Movements Diagram in the *Further Supplementary Regulations*.
- 13.2. All trolleys transporting equipment i.e. tyres, fuel etc., when moved in a public area must be moved by a minimum of two personnel. A minimum of one person to push the trolley/drum and a minimum of one person acting as a spotter is required at all times.
- 13.3. All Competition Automobiles travelling in the paddock other than to or from a scheduled session must be pushed. One person must be acting as a spotter at all times.
- 13.4. A speed limit of 10km/h applies to all vehicles in the paddock.

14. RACE TRACK WALK

- 14.1. Teams are only permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Thursday 18th July 2024 between **1530hrs and 1830hrs (AEST)**.
- 14.2. All personnel participating in the Race Track walk must wear high visibility vest/clothing.

15. DOCUMENT CHECK & SCRUTINY

- 15.1. Document check will be completed electronically unless otherwise organised with the Secretary of the Event. The Category Administrator/Manager must provide the Secretary of the Event with electronic copies of Entry forms. Vehicle Logbooks are to be dropped off at the Scrutineering

- Offices located in the Civic Theatre building for infield categories and in the Lou Lister paddock for outfield categories.
- 15.2. Category Administrator/Managers will be given the Pit Lane Access passes for the Event by the Secretary of the Event. Each team must complete the [Pit Crew Disclaimers](#) form prior to being issued Pit Lane Access passes. Without a pass, no crew member will be permitted to be in the Pit Lane. The maximum number of persons permitted in Pit Lane per race vehicle will be two (2) for GR Cup and four (4) for Porsche Carrera Cup, Touring Car Masters and V8 SuperUtes.
 - 15.3. The signed Pit Crew disclaimers must be returned to the Secretary of the Event by the category's first session on Friday 19th July, along with any unissued passes.
 - 15.4. Any series accreditation displaying the persons photo and name does not require a Pit Lane Access Sticker
 - 15.5. Each competitor must complete the ["Statement of Vehicle Compliance"](#) This documents must be provided via email to the Secretary of the Event prior to competition commencing.
 - 15.6. Further scrutiny, technical examinations and Parc Fermé may be conducted following incidents and at any other times during the Event at the discretion of the Chief Scrutineer or a Technical Delegate.
 - 15.7. Any car, or driver, may be prevented from further participation in the event for reasons of safety.
 - 15.8. Helmets and other driver apparel may be checked at any time in the Marshalling Area.
 - 15.9. Competition numbers, all advertising signage, and functioning timing transmitters must be in place on the vehicle before it is driven onto the circuit at any time.
 - 15.10. Tyre Regulations will be as per category regulations.
- 16. FUEL AND FUEL HANDLING & STORAGE**
- 16.1. Competitors must comply with their category series regulations regarding the use of fuel unless varied below. Competitors are not permitted to bring their own fuel on site. Required fuel must be arranged through **RaceFuels Pty Ltd (Mark Tierney 0419 511 517)** or by email fuelorder@racefuels.com.au.
 - 16.2. No fuel or storage containers are allowed to be brought into the Circuit by Competitors, except for fuel already in the Competition Automobile. RaceFuels on site will provide all fuel and storage containers.
 - 16.3. Competitors may not refuel their Competition Automobiles in Pit Lane.
 - 16.4. When refuelling or undertaking any activity with fuel in the paddock/garages:
 - 16.4.1. The Automobile's engine must be switched off.
 - 16.4.2. At least one crew member must be designated as a fire attendant and be in possession of at least 1 x 4.5kg (or larger) dry powder fire extinguisher.
 - 16.4.3. The designated fire attendant must not perform any other task during the activity.
 - 16.4.4. A drip/catch mat/tray capable of containing any spillage must be positioned below the refuelling point of the Automobile
- 17. WASTE OIL**
- 17.1. All personnel must be aware of the fact that **NO** waste of any nature may be tipped into any storm water drain.
 - 17.2. All storm water drains lead directly to the local waterways and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will be monitoring the situation in the lead up and throughout the Event.
 - 17.3. This ban includes the washing of any wheel rims within the vicinity of storm water drains.
 - 17.4. Competitors are advised that the EPA is taking an extremely proactive approach to this matter and are put on notice that any infringement of this directive will result in action being taken by either the Promoter or the EPA or both. The EPA has the ability to prosecute offenders with heavy penalties.
 - 17.5. The Promoter has provided an area for disposal of waste oil and/or fluid products that are located near the Circuit fuel dump. This is not for the disposal of used parts (i.e., oil filters etc.).
- 18. IN-CAR CAMERAS AND VIDEO FOOTAGE**
- 18.1. No in-Car cameras other than those fitted by personnel authorised by the broadcaster and/or cameras fitted for Category Judicial purposes are allowed.
 - 18.1.1. This includes but not limited to any camera mounted to the Car and/or the body or helmet of the Driver or a passenger in Meeting rides. Handheld cameras area also not permitted.

- 18.2. All in-Car footage taken during a Supercars event remains the property of Supercars Australia Pty Ltd. Competitors are permitted access to the video images recorded by the cameras, however the footage is “strictly for private internal purposes”; that is, it cannot be sold, licensed, broadcast, published, posted on social media, commercially exploited, or otherwise publicly displayed or distributed, including in any case via internet.

19. TIMING

- 19.1. The Finish line will be the control line for all timing purposes.
- 19.2. All Sessions will be “time certain”. Competitors will be advised if the listed finish times vary on the day.
- 19.3. Timing of all Support Category Sessions will be by electronic means using the Australian Dorian System, and all Competitors must have a working DATA 1 Timing Transmitter fitted to their Competition Automobile prior to scrutineering and during all track activity.
- 19.4. A Competition Automobile without an operational timing transmitter during any session may not have a time recorded until the transmitter is functioning and operating correctly.
- 19.5. Transmitters can be purchased /arranged from Dorian Industries P/L ph.: 03 9931 1371 or from Timetronics P/L e: timing@timetronics.com.au.

20. GENERAL

- 20.1. Any protests or appeals, if any, must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.
- 20.2. Awards will be as per category Regulations
- 20.3. Judges of Fact will be detailed in *Further Supplementary Regulations* or by Bulletin at the circuit and posted on the electronic noticeboard.
- 20.4. Strictly **NO** bicycles, tricycles, motorised scooters, roller blades, skateboards or similar devices are permitted to be used in the Pit Lane or Paddock Areas.
- 20.5. Buggies are not permitted to be used by support category teams at this Event.

21. ADDITIONAL FLAG POST

- 21.1. In addition to the flags shown at the control line, the following flags will be shown at the flag post after Turn 8 on drivers left – Black Flag, Black Flag with Orange Disc, Bad Sportsmanship Flag. If a driver is shown either of the first two of these flags at this flag post, that driver must enter the Pit Lane the next time they reach the Pit Entry.

22. DRIVER BEHAVIOUR AND TRACK LIMITS

- 22.1. Driver behaviour is detailed in the Code of Driving Conduct in the Circuit Race Standing Regulations in the Motorsport Australia Manual. Each Sector Marshal is designated as a Judge of Fact with regard to shortening the course, and appropriate action will be taken if infringements are observed. Any driver exceeding the track limits, as defined by the solid line at the track edges, may be subject to a penalty.

23. COVID-19 RESPONSE

- 23.1 Any additional Event specific COVID-19 management protocols will be specified by the Promoter.
- 23.2 Under no circumstances may anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend the Event.

24. INSURANCE

Certain public, property, professional indemnity, and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Program Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au.

25. SAFE WORKING CONDITIONS – SAFETY 1ST

- 25.1. The Event will be conducted in accordance with the Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st and Risk management Policies which are available to be viewed at www.motorsport.org.au.
- 25.2. Competitors are reminded that they are responsible for the working conditions of their associated personnel at all times and must ensure that all applicable safe working conditions are met.

26. WHS COMPLAINEE OFFICER

- 26.1. The Site Safety Advisor for this Event TBA in the *Further Supplementary Regulations*.

27. 24HR VENUE SECURITY

- 27.1. The 24-hour security phone number is **Mobile:** 0498 252 121

28. UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLES (UAV) PROHIBITION

- 28.1 The use of Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV-drones and similar) is prohibited at any motorsport Event unless specifically approved by Motorsport Australia and must comply with [Motorsport Australia RPA Policy](#).
- 28.2 This prohibition extends for the period of the Event period over the entire Event.
- 28.3 It also includes the prohibition of the use of any unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV), drone or similar device over the Event area which is being operated from outside of the event over the declared area during the Event period.
- 28.4 A breach of this prohibition will result in disqualification from the Event for any offending Competitor and or Team and Driver/s. All credentials or admission tickets issued to any offending Competitor or Team, and associated personnel will also be withdrawn.
- 28.5 The prohibition and Penalty for a breach of same as outlined above, is in addition to any Penalty/Penalties that may occur as a result of breaching Civil Aviation Authority (CASA) regulations in relation to the use of UAVs in controlled airspace, and over areas containing significant numbers of people.

29. INTEGRITY

- 29.1. Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at motorsport.org.au.
- 29.2. Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.
- 29.3. Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.

30. SMOKING

- 30.1 Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and "vaping") and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.

31. OTHER REGULATIONS

- 31.1. For any Repco Supercars Championship activity, please refer to the Supercars Championship Supplementary and/or Further Supplementary Regulations, which are issued separately. If there is a conflict between the Supercars Championship Supplementary Regulations and Support Category Supplementary Regulations, the Supercars Regulations will take priority for Supercars Championship activity.

32. MERCHANDISE SELLING

- 32.1. The selling of any team merchandise without prior approval in writing by the Promoter is prohibited.
